Since 1791

On 17 May 1791, King Christian VII granted the smallholder Peter Andesen permission to fire bricks at Nybøl Nor.

The brickworks he established is now owned by Christian A. Petersen and his daughters – the seventh and eighth generations of the family to run it.

Over the last 230+ years, Petersen Tegl has evolved from a local to an international company with export to >50 countries – highly specialized in the production of unique handmade brick products, which are greatly esteemed and valued by architects and designers.





D-Bricks

Waterstruck

D-Bricks are waterstruck on machines that emulate manual processes. This gives them their unique structure.

The bricks are moulded wet-on-wet, using slurry in natural clay hues.

The resulting play of colour is due to the natural production and firing processes.

Each brick has a wide range of colour shades, which ensure a brickwork that is unique to Petersen Tegl and unparalleled in its richness.



D-Bricks Facts

- Original waterstruck bricks
- Ingredients: clay, water, air and fire
- Three standard formats:
 - DNF: 228 x 108 x 54 mm
approx. 63 pcs. per m²
 - HF: 220 x 105 x 65 mm
approx. 56 pcs. per m²
 - FF: 228 x 108 x 40 mm
approx. 80 pcs. per m²
- 39 colour variants
- 'Frog' used for 40+ years, reducing production time and resources
- All sides can be displayed
- Made from local clay
- Mixed at the brickworks to ensure homogeneity in the brickwork
- Special mixes on request



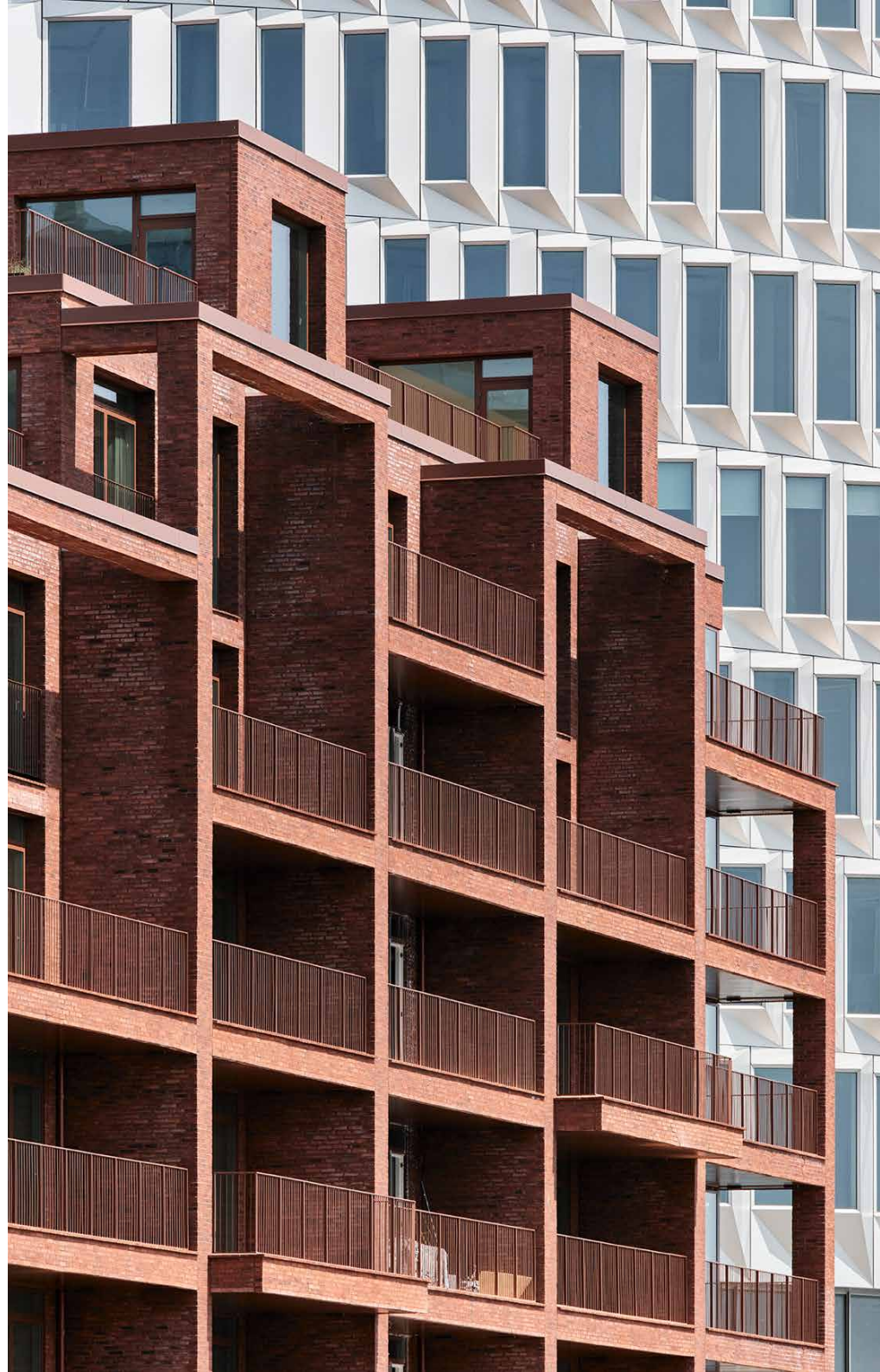

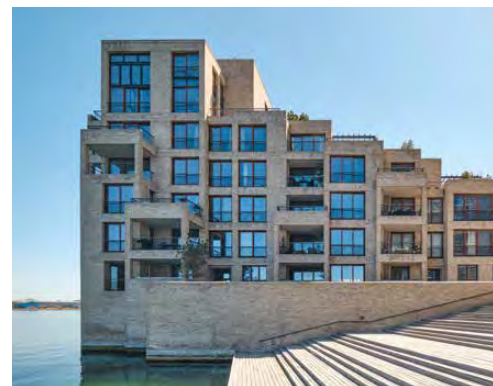

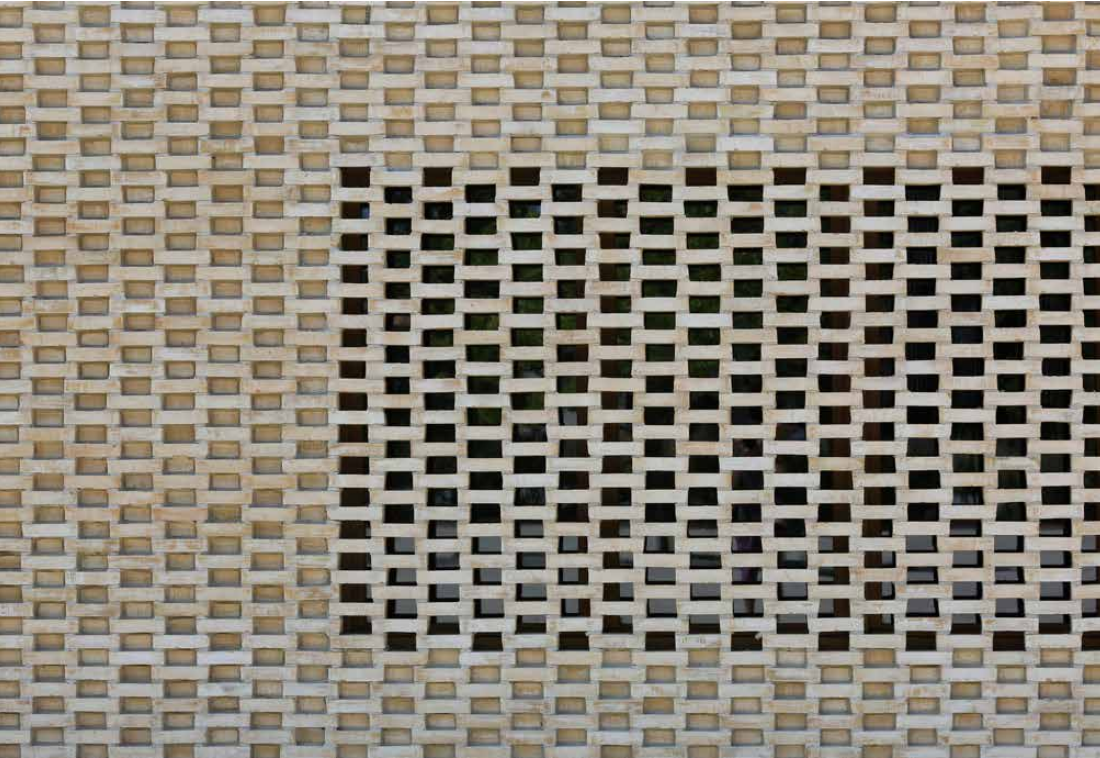
